ANSWERS TO NOVEMBER STAMP QUIZ

THESE three stamps, depicting activities on October, November and December, are part of a set issued by the Republic of China (Taiwan) in 1970. (Scott 1691-1693).

STAMP OF THE MONTH

NITED STATES — The definitive issue of 1890-93 remains fertile ground for U.S. collectors. Stamps in the series depict presidents, statesmen and warriors; Benjamin Franklin, George Washington, Andrew



Jackson, Abraham Lincoln, Ulysses S. Grant, James A. Garfield, William T. Sherman, Daniel Webster, Henry Clay, Thomas Jefferson and Oliver Hazard Perry.

A cap on left "2" variety of the 2¢ Washington stamp (Scott 220a) was created by a breakdown of the transfer roll. This interesting production variety is missing from most U.S. collections. It is always very difficult to find in a very fine or better grade.

The Scott Standard Postage Stamp Catalogue values the variety at \$140 in unused original gum condition and \$400 in mint never hinged condition. This stamp is a good buy at or near Scott catalog value.

Se-tenant pairs with one example of Scott 220a and one example with the cap on both "2s" (Scott 220c) exist from plate VV246. They are very scarce and desirable.
